JOB SUMMARY:

Through our Summer Intern Program, law students will provide essential services to tenants facing housing instability in Allegheny County. This is a 10-week, immersive program in housing law. After a week of substantive training, students may provide advice, negotiation assistance, and representation* at district justice and arbitration hearings under the supervision of experienced NLS attorneys

*Law students that have completed their evidence course will need to be certified by the PA Supreme Court to appear in court. Certification is not a requirement to be considered for a position.

- 40-hour per week positions are open to current 1Ls and 2Ls (upcoming 2Ls and 3Ls).
- Law school graduates will not be considered.
- Hourly rate is \$18.75
- Offices are located at 928 Penn Avenue in downtown Pittsburgh.
- The program runs in-person from June 3 through August 9, 2024.
